Henham Steam & Country Show Terms and Conditions for Exhibitors

- The application form must be completed in full in black ink, in block capitals, accepting on behalf yourself, all of your party and any guests, the terms and conditions and if your application is accepted and where applicable, If your exhibit is accepted, you will be notified. Post-dated cheques will not be accepted. Submission of an application form does not necessarily mean acceptance. Applications will not be accepted from persons under the age of 18 years. Special requests or requirements normally cannot be accepted, but any request must be notified, in writing, to the section steward at the time of application and which we will endeavour to meet.
- 2) If accepted, arrival times are 10.00am to 7.00pm on Thursday or Friday immediately prior to the event and from 7.30am on the days of the weekend. Arrivals outside of these times you will be directed to the holding area until the correct time, you must vacate the site by 10.00am on the day after the event. All exhibitors are required to keep their area and the surrounding area free from rubbish and debris and to leave the site clean and clear. Rubbish disposal points are available around the site.
- 3) We reserve the right to refuse entry to any person, group, or organisation.
- You and all members of your party are required to immediately abide by and carry out any instructions given to you by any event official, police officer, fire officer or any other official. You may only use the specific entrances and exits as designated and sign-posted by the organisers.
